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## Driver Education February 24- March 7, 2025

SGI and provincial school divisions offer the mandatory driver education program to <u>high school</u> <u>students</u> free of charge (one-time). By participating in this program you can have your learner's licence at age 15.

Driver Education will be offered to Avery Outreach Students starting Feb 24 to Mar. 7, from 9:00 am-12:00 pm.

The program has **30 hours of in-class** instruction and **6 hours of in-car** instruction. The <u>Class 7 learners</u> knowledge tests are administered as part of the program and completed during the in-class instruction.

Alberta students are eligible to take this course if they currently have a learner's license.

Saskatchewan students must have an <u>SGI customer number</u> to enroll in high school driver education. This can be done well in advance - the sooner the better!

- A) Visit a motor license issuer to:
  - 1. Get yourself a customer number
    - Bring <u>documents</u> proving your identity and entitlement to be in Canada, and contact information.
      - **Note:** Section C of a <u>Signature/Guarantor Form</u> (pdf, 310 kb) can be used to verify a first-time driver's signature.
    - Once your identification is established, you will receive a Personal Identification Document containing your customer number.
    - Present your identification document to your high school driving instructor.
      Note: If you currently have an SGI <u>non-driver photo ID</u>, your customer number is indicated on the photo card.
- 2. Register a valid email address
  - It is required to write your driver exam online and to use MySGI.

\*\*\*If a student misses more than 3 hours of classroom training, they will be removed from driver education. The ministry will only fund students to take this program one time.
